Kinsey

- 0 – Exclusively attracted to someone of an opposite / other gender
- 1 – Mostly attracted to someone of an opposite / other gender
- 2 – More often attracted to someone of an opposite or other gender, but also attracted to someone of the same gender
- 3 – Equally attracted to someone of the same and an opposite / other gender
- 4 – More often attracted to someone of the same gender, but also attracted to someone of an opposite / other gender
- 5 - Mostly attracted to someone of the same gender
- 6 - Exclusively attracted to some of the same gender
